C. Contextual Information Surrounding 2021-2022 and the Impact on Data

A school's data is impacted by what is going on in the greater community, the city, the zone and the province. Ecole St. Mary (ESM) began the year impacted by the COVID-19 Pandemic. We began the year conservatively in order to follow Alberta Health Guidelines and keep students safe. This meant no mixing of groups, no group gatherings (these were done virtually) until May, separate recess for different groups, no parents or volunteers in the building. Assemblies, liturgies, mass and bringing people together did not commence until May of 2022.

- -Cocurricular was paused and we were limited in running club, volleyball, basketball programs. Running Club, After School Skating, Science Sizzle were not available. Leadership groups were on pause. A badminton program was available in late May and June for grade 3,4,5,6. As such participation in co-curricular and clubs was not possible.
- -Provincial Achievement Exams (PAT's) were completed by grade 6 students, after having several years of disruption to learning. There were no PAT's for the 2020 and 2021 school years.
- -The Accountability Report is completed by parents/guardians, certificated staff and students in February.
- -Our School Survey surveyed 48 grade 4 students, 46 grade 5 students, and 32 grade 6 students.
- -Accountability Ratings had 72 Respondents overall, 11 parents, 53 students and 8 teachers. This is a small sample size of respondents which impacts findings. Grade 4 parents are surveyed (11 out of 60+ families.)
- -It is certain that the restrictions and limitations affected survey results.
- -Due to restrictions, we returned to field trip and grouping classes in May of 2022.
- -Learning disruptions in the 2020, 2021 school years will continue to impact learning and survey results as we return to normal.



Comment on Results: In four areas of Assurance Measures, Ecole St. Mary (ESM) maintains a VERY HIGH achievement with an overall rating of Excellent. ESM is above Alberta and at a VERY HIGH achievement level in Student Learning, Citizenship, Education Quality, Welcoming and Caring Schools, Parental Involvement. Although higher than the province average, there is a slight decline due to the lingering effects of the COVID 19 pandemic and lingering restrictions through the 2021-2022 school year. Access to services shows a decline due to accessibility.



Comment on Results: We reflect positively on these results of Citizenship Measure Details. ESM is higher than the Authority, higher than the Province, and in the Very High domain. Parent results are down from 2021 to 2022. Students were not able to participate in many of the traditional citizenship activities that we usually take part in, including field trips and working with groups outside of the school. Student responses show an improvement. We look to take part in more active citizenship as we recover from Covid restrictions and ensure we communicate active citizenship in a more effective way.




Comment on Results: Education Quality if very important. We are proud that we maintain a VERY HIGH rating. There is a slight decline in student results due to not being able to return completely to certain classroom activities. We had not yet returned to groupings, mixed cohorts, and hands on activities in order to contain any spread of disease. This impacted the results. We will continue to focus on engagements, hands on activities and work to continually improve our Education Quality. Although there is a decline, we are still above both the Authority and the Province in Education Quality.





Safe and Caring - Measure Details








Rigor

Students who find the classroom instruction is well-organized, with a clear purpose, and with immediate and appropriate feedback that helps them learn.

- In this school, students rated rigor 8.3 out of 10; the Canadian norm for these grades is 8.3.
- In this school, rigor was rated 8.4 out of 10 by girls and 8.2 out of 10 by boys. The Canadian norm for girls is 8.3 and for boys is 8.2.

Comment on Results: Students in grade 4 and 5 find that the classroom instruction is rigorous. We will work to engage and improve our grade 6 student reported results. ESM is in line with the Canadian norm in this area.




Positive teacher-student relations

Students who feel teachers are responsive to their needs, and encourage independence with a democratic approach.

- In this school, positive teacher-student relations were rated 8.4 out of 10; the Canadian norm for these grades is 8.3.
- In this school, positive teacher-student relations were rated 8.6 out of 10 by girls and 8.2 out of 10 by boys. The Canadian norm for girls is 8.5 and for boys is 8.1.

Comment on Results: Positive teacher-student relations are integral for a student to feel successful and safe at school. Students report that they are satisfied with positive student teacher relations.

G. Administrator's Message

Overall, we are pleased and proud of our school results. We are achieving higher than both the authority and the province in most areas. Although we declined slightly in several areas, we are proud to say that we are achieving very high results. With this data, we will work to improve certain areas where we declined slightly such as citizenship and parental involvement. We expect an increase in PAT results as students return to normal and disrupted learning supports and interventions continue to support students in their learning.

We are blessed to work with our students. We work hard to meet them where they are at, and ensure that all students experience growth and success. ESM is a safe and caring school environment where staff works hard to make sure students are supported academically, spiritually, social-emotionally. Ecole St. Mary is a special place to be.
